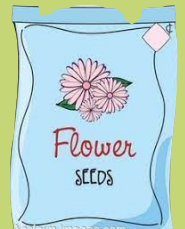

## **SCIAF launches Emergency Appeal for Syria and Türkiye**

**People in Syria and Türkiye urgently need your help.**



In the early morning of 6 February, multiple earthquakes, the largest being a devastating 7.8 magnitude, struck large areas of northern Syria and southern Türkiye with devastating effects. Many thousands of people died as they slept and many more have been injured. Countless others have been left without food and shelter, with many in need of medical and psychological assistance.

SCIAF has responded immediately to the calls from those who are working on the ground providing emergency relief. We are in regular contact with our partners in the area, who are continuing to assess the damage of the earthquake and give emergency support to those in need.

Families who have lost everything are in need of warm blankets, clothes, food and places to sleep, with many having fled their homes in the middle of the night into snowy streets and freezing conditions.

We have pledged £20,000 initially to provide relief and shelter for those whose homes have been destroyed.

With 16,000 already confirmed dead and the death toll expected to rise, families caught up in this humanitarian emergency need to know that they can rely on the international community's ongoing support.

That is why SCIAF has launched an emergency appeal for Syria and Türkiye which will allow us to react quickly to the needs of those whose lives have been affected by this devastating natural disaster.

**At next Sunday's Masses, 19th February, there will be a second collection towards this important appeal.**
