The Financial Council recently looked at all immediate and long term fabric & maintenance projects we have. Some are only in the stage of discussion and searching for financial estimates:~

- Replacing all the wooden church windows with PVC/aluminium double glazed windows.
- Replacing the entrance steps.
- Reorganising a place for the tabernacle.
- Making the entrance more welcoming.
- Painting of inside and outside of the church.
- Roof.



It was decided to create a special Fabric & Maintenance Fund(F & M Fund) in which we will begin to save and put aside resources only for this end.

As a special treat we as a parish would like to offer more to you and your child to finalise their preparation.

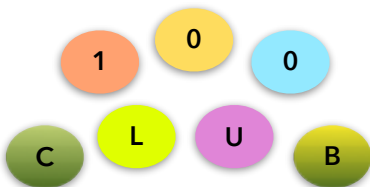
On Sunday 26th May all families are invited to a retreat as detailed below.
