The Offertory

The Offertory is an integral part of the celebration of the Eucharist every Sunday. This is not only because the collection, which is part of the Offertory, is the primary source of income for the parish but it is also an expression of our gratitude to God.

By our baptism we become stewards of God's gifts to us. Part of that stewardship is to weigh up our various obligations against our limited resources. Through the Offertory we also are witnessing to our children and the world about our values and what is important to us.

Our parish is very generous in sharing as is reflected in the special collections we have and causes we support. One of our principle expressions of our sharing is our support for The Gate. As a parish we have officially been supporting for many years with small financial donations but mostly with food that people leave at the entrance of the church next to Our Lady's altar.

We are always trying to enrich our liturgy. We intend, at Sunday masses (vigil included), ask two people, at the Offertory, to bring up in the Offertory procession a basket symbolically representing our food donations destined for The Gate.

At times this may be exchanged for another cause or our support for our Society of St. Vincent de Paul.
