**SUNDAY 29TH SEPTEMBER 2024 5.30PM**

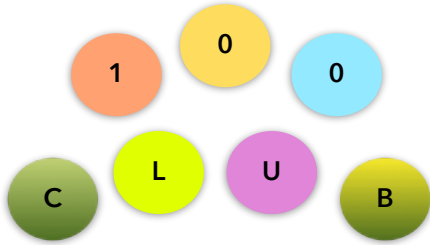
