## Apologies!

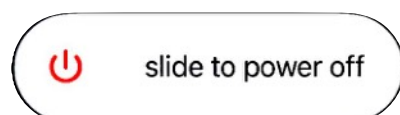
Each week I try to juggle the various news items, "pray for" lists, etc, to fit onto 4 pages for printing.

# NOVEMBER



The sacrifice of the mass is the greatest prayer we Catholics have. It is therefore important to remember our deceased loved ones at mass.

Normally we do this round about the anniversary of their death. However, it is a tradition of the Church that in the month of November we remember our deceased loved ones. We pray for them and ask them to pray for us.

Envelopes are available at the back of the church for you to list your intentions for the Holy Souls.

These intentions will be included at all masses celebrated both by Fr Mike in St. Bernadette's. Please try to leave your mass intentions in the baskets by last Sunday of October.

There is no stipulation regarding how much your contribution for a mass stipend should be. However the intention behind the stipend is not to "pay" but to involve some form of sacrifice on the donors part and offer a contribution to the priest's living expenses.

It would be excellent if people made the effort to go to at least one mid-week mass during the month to be actually involved in praying for your deceased loved ones.

Friday evenings we will remember our deceased priests especially those who have served recently in our area : Fr. Wallace, Fr. Michael Milton and Mgr Canon John Harty.

The Wednesday and Saturday morning masses people will be able to place a cross at the offertory to represent our deceased relatives.
